A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL LEVIES FOR VOTER
APPROVAL ON MARCH 12, 2019

Whereas each year the Idaho State Legislature fails to fully fund Idaho's public educational institutions and requires Kootenai County property owners to make up the short fall through supplemental levies; and

Whereas the Idaho Department of Education consistently fails to secure funds to adequately fund Idaho's public educational institutions; and

Whereas the Coeur d'Alene School District No. 271, is proposing a maintenance and operation supplemental levy to provide for the safety, education, mental health and advancement of its students; and

Whereas the Post Falls School District No. 273, is proposing a maintenance and operation supplemental levy to provide for the safety, education, mental health and advancement of its students; and

Whereas the Lakeland Joint School District No. 272 is proposing a maintenance and operation supplemental levy to provide for the safety, education, mental health and advancement of its students; and

Whereas the Plummer-Worley Joint School District No. 44 is proposing a maintenance and operation supplemental levy to provide for the safety, education, mental health and advancement of its students; now, therefore be it

Resolved, that the Kootenai County Democratic Central Committee:
Demands that the Idaho State Legislature fully fund Idaho's public education system without reliance on supplemental levies subject to voter approval; and

For the benefit of current students and educators, supports the passage of the Coeur d'Alene School District No. 271, Post Falls School District no. 273, Lakeland Joint School District No. 272, and Plummer-Worley Joint School District No. 44 maintenance and operation supplemental levies on March 12, 2019.
